**Psychology Department Breadth Requirement:** All majors must take at least one course from each of the following five areas:

Area D: Social-Personality	PSY 205 - Social Psychology PSY 208 – Environmental Psychology PSY 215 - Psychology of Personality
Area E: Clinical-Counseling	PSY 202 - Abnormal Psychology PSY 203 – Clinical Psychology PSY 260 – Health Psychology

**Advanced Seminar or Research Course:** All majors are required to take *at least one* upper level seminar or research course from the list provided below:

PSY 412 - Advanced Developmental Psychology  
PSY 415 - Advanced Personality-Social Psychology  
PSY 425 – Advanced Experimental Psychology  
PSY 439 - Community Psychology  
PSY 450 - Research Seminar in Psychology

**NOTE:** The above courses have numerous prerequisites which students are advised to fulfill as early as possible in their program.
