

# **2021-2022 Verification Worksheet** Federal Student Aid Programs

Your application was selected for review in a process called Verification. In this process, your institution will be comparing information from your application with copies of you and your parent(s)' or spouse's (if you are married) 2019 IRS Federal Tax Return Form, W-2 forms, or other financial documents. The law says we have the right to ask you for this information before awarding federal aid. If there are differences between your application information and your financial documents, you or your institution may need to make corrections electronically or by using your Student Aid Report (SAR).

Complete this verification worksheet and submit it to your financial aid administrator as soon as possible to prevent a delay in the processing of financial aid.

#### Instructions

1. Collect your and your parent(s)' or spouse's (if you are married) financial documents (e.g., IRS Federal Tax Return, W-2 forms).

2. Talk to your financial aid administrator if you have questions about completing this worksheet.

3. Complete and sign the worksheet—you and your parent(s) or spouse as applicable.

4. Submit the completed worksheet, tax forms, and any other documents your institution requests to your financial aid administrator.

5. Your financial aid administrator will compare information on this worksheet and any supporting documents with the information you submitted on your application. You or your institution may need to make corrections electronically or by using your SAR.
