### **ACCOMMODATIONS**

To request accommodations, students with disabilities need to complete an Accommodation Intake Form and meet with a Disability Service Provider in AccessAbility Services to discuss the accommodations they are requesting.

### **ACADEMIC COACHING**

Students receiving accommodations can meet on a regular basis by appointment with one of our Academic Coaches to work on time management, organization, writing, and study skills. Academic Coaches present various learning strategies to students to improve their academic skills.
