## Westside Campus Center

The University offers 37 undergraduate programs and 17 master's degree programs. The already low cost to students may be supplemented by financial aid, which is used by 40% of all full-time students. Western has approximately 7,000 students, approximately 4,500 of them full-time undergraduates. Western has six residence halls offering co-educational and apartment-style living, which provide housing for almost 30% of undergraduates. The Housing Office will assist in making housing arrangements in the Danbury area.

### Athletics and Clubs

The 79,000-square-foot William A. O'Neill Athletic and Convocation Center opened in January of 1995. In 2005, the Westside Athletic Complex opened on the Westside campus. The WAC features a state-of-the-art SprintTurf surface, seating for 2,500, offices for coaches, a training and equipment room and several locker rooms.

Fourteen intercollegiate athletics programs are offered including football, women's and men's soccer, women's volleyball, women's tennis and field hockey in the fall; men's and women's basketball and women's swimming in the winter; and baseball, softball, men's tennis and men's and women's lacrosse in the spring. There are more than 60 student clubs and organizations on campus.

### Freshman Admission Guidelines

Each application is assessed individually. Listed below are the general guidelines used in evaluating an applicant's academic record.

- High school diploma or GED
- SAT (1000 guideline) — Reading comp/math
- Rank in Class (RIC) — top 50%
- B minus average in the following:
  - 4 years of English
  - 3 years math (Alg. I, Geom., Alg. 2)
  - 2 years social sciences, including U.S. history
  - 2 years laboratory science
  - 2 to 3 years foreign language (3 recommended)

### University Scholars Program

### Financial Aid

Scholarship and financial aid candidates must complete the Free Application For Student Aid (FAFSA). The output document resulting from FAFSA must be received in WestConn's data files with a valid index number by March 30 in order for you to be considered an on-time applicant. The recommended electronic filing date is March 15.

## Westside Campus

Nursing, education and business departments may have additional requirements. Coursework in computer science, visual arts, theatre arts, music or dance may be substituted for one of the above academic areas.

Applications for the fall semester should be received by May 1.

### Transfer Students

Applicants are considered to be transfer students if they have 12 or more credits. A minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA is required for consideration for all students with 12 to 45 credits. Students with 45 or more credits will be required to meet academic major GPA standards to be admitted.

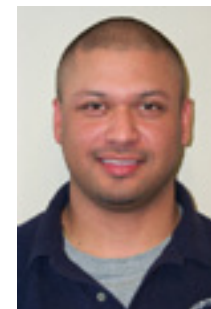

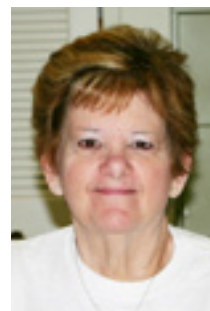

# HEAD COACH - RITUSH VENUGOPAL



Ritush Venugopal came to WestConn with an impressive history of coaching and directorships.

In his third season at the Colonials' helm, in 2010, Venugopal assembled a team that won a program-best 13 matches, won its first-ever Little East Conference regular-season and Tournament titles and appeared in its first-ever NCAA Division III National Tournament.

He was the Director of Tennis at Ridgefield (CT) Athletic Club from 1995 to 2006 and coached the Ridgefield High School varsity tennis team from 2002 to 2007. Since 2006, Venugopal has been Co-Director of Elite Juniors and Match-Making at the Four Seasons Racquet Club. He recently was named Director of the Western Field Club.

Since 1998, he has been the Head Coordinator of the New England USTA Fairfield County Club Summer League.

In 2005, Venugopal coached the Champion of the USTA Open Nationals Team Tennis Championships in Las Vegas. Two years later, he mentored the New England Men's USTA 3.5 Champions at the 2007 National Championships.

His playing career included qualifying for the Pilot Pen Tournament in New Haven, CT in 1997. From 1992 to 1995, he was ranked among the Top 16 in the Nation in NAIA Division I while he earned a degree in Marketing and Management at Graceland University in Lamoni, IA.

In 1989 and 1990, he was ranked #10 in the Men's Division in India.

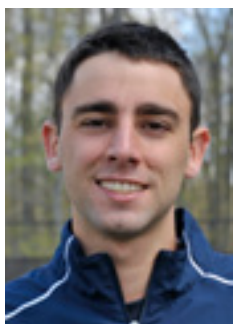

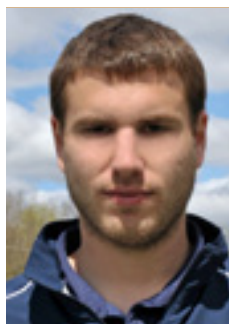

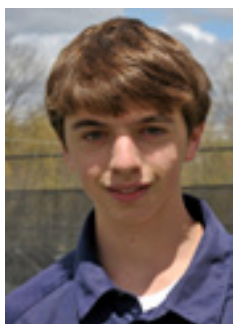
