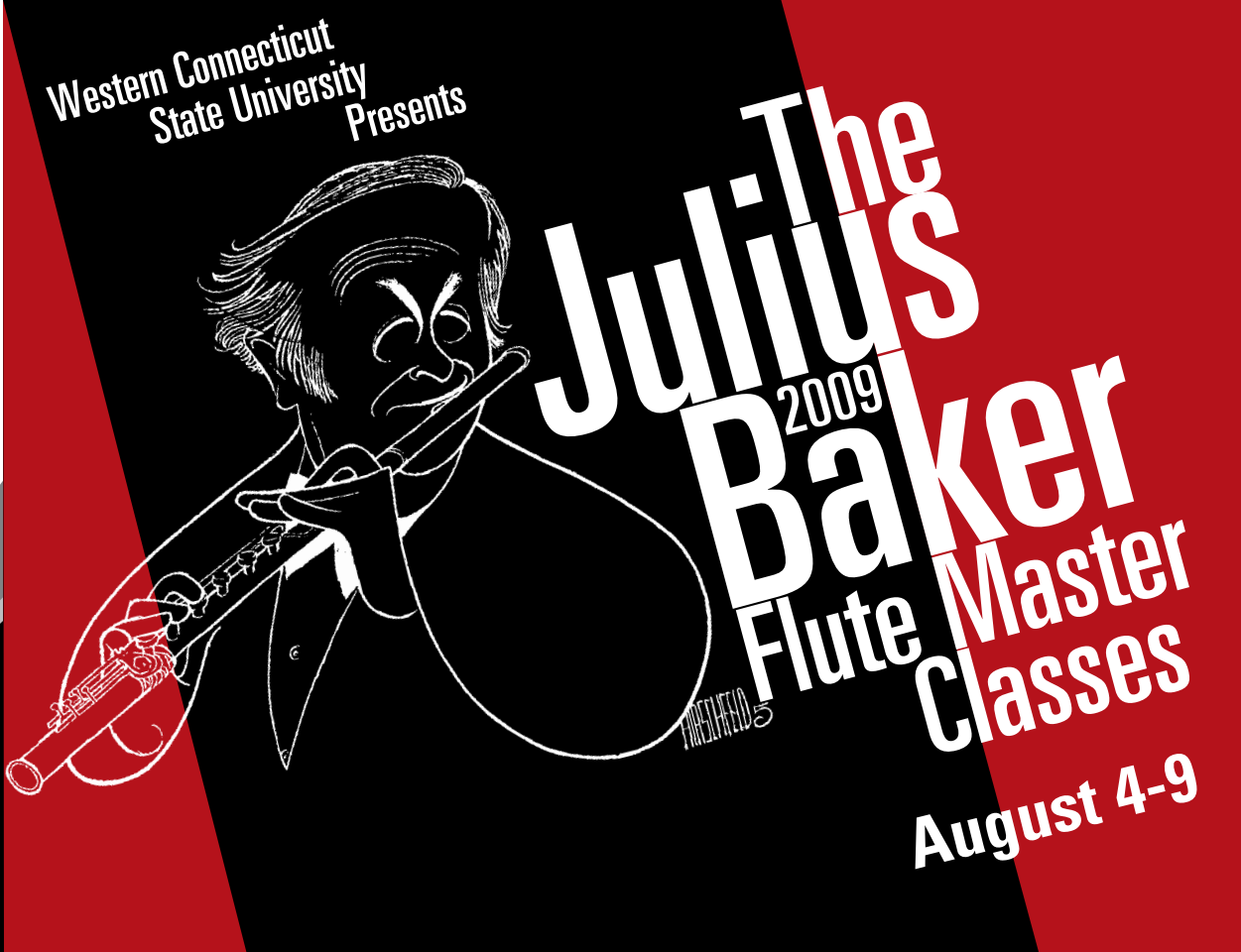

- a \$100.00 deposit—refunded only to students who are not accepted as performers.
- A brief resume of playing experience.
- Performers must include an recording of at least 10 minutes containing 3 pieces or excerpts of contrasting styles. At least one selection must be accompanied by piano.
 - Day auditors do not have to pre-register.

Application Deadlines (postmarked):

Performers: May 15, 2009
Auditors: June 15, 2009

Classes:

The classes will consist of 10 three-hour master classes, as well as ensemble classes conducted by Vanita Jones. The event will conclude with a concert.

Yamaha prizes will be awarded to the top players in each session.

Repertory:

Linda Mark is the accompanist for the classes. Any flute repertoire is acceptable including orchestral excerpts. Performers can expect to play at least 3 times.

Accommodations:
