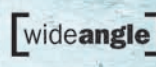

Philanthropist Abigail Disney will deliver the Steven D. Neuwirth lecture following the showing of her film "Pray the Devil Back to Hell," a documentary about a group of women who brought peace to war-torn Liberia.

Disney is co-founder and co-president of the Daphne Foundation, a progressive social change foundation that makes grants to grassroots organizations working with low-income communities in New York City. Since 1991, the Daphne Foundation has made millions of dollars in grants in areas ranging from women's rights to AIDS advocacy, children's health, labor conditions, incarceration and community organizing. She is the daughter of Roy Disney, a longtime executive at the Walt Disney Co., which was founded by his father and uncle.
