The Arts and Sciences Exploratory Studies student may explore different academic areas prior to identifying a major course of study for a degree. Students should concentrate on courses that satisfy general education requirements as well as those that provide insights into areas of interest. Exploratory Studies students are provided an advisor with whom they should meet several times a semester to review progress. All Bachelor degree programs necessitate the general education courses be completed and a minimum total of 122 credits to graduate. Some academic programs require a minimum grade average for acceptance. Read the WCSU catalog and discuss pertinent matters with your faculty advisor. Students should attempt to determine a choice of major by the time they accumulate 60 credits.
