PSY 475, the first course in the sequence, cannot be taken sooner than second semester in the junior year or after at least 75 SH have been completed. PSY 324 and Advanced Seminar (PSY 412, 415, 425, 439 or 450) are a prerequisites for PSY 475. Please consult with your advisor if you are interested in this optional opportunity.
