These requirements reflect the minimum ensemble requirements; however, *full-time music majors must perform in a major ensemble, according to their vocal/instrument, every semester*. An ensemble credit in excess of the minimum will be applied as elective credit.

Students must maintain a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 (subject to change). Grades from other institutions will be used to calculate the cumulative G.P.A. for admission to and retention in the education program. WCSU graduation requires a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. (subject to change) on WCSU coursework.

This major may be selected by a student seeking a music education teaching certificate. Formal admission by the Education Department to the Music Education Program is required. Students must fill an application with the Music and Education departments for formal program acceptance as a music education major by Nov. 1st or April 1st of their sophomore year. Passing Praxis I (or a waiver) is required before admittance to the education program will be granted. Although not a requirement for graduation, passing scores on the appropriate Praxis II exam are necessary for program completion and subsequent recommendation for certification.
