Requirements for admission or application to the program:

Students accepted into the program are expected to have completed all course prerequisites for the program. To be considered for admission to the minor program at WestConn, a student must be enrolled in an academic major other than music and must formally audition for the Department of Music. An average GPA of 2.30 in all minor courses must be maintained to fulfill the requirements of the minor.
