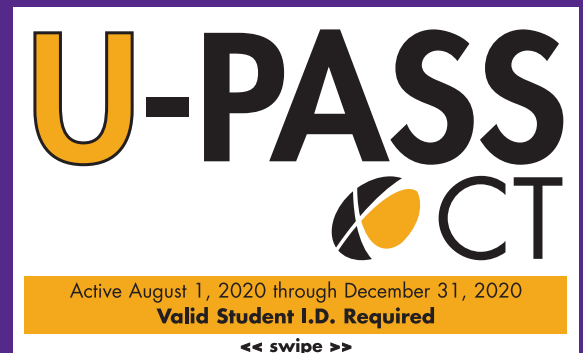




Your Off-Campus Commuting Options

Use Your U-PASS – Ride for **FREE!**

Western CT State University students can ride most transit services in Connecticut for **FREE** using your U-Pass and valid student ID. **More info at CTrides.com/u-pass**



Bus:

HARTransit provides local daily service in the greater Danbury area. Routes **1, 4, and 7** service WCSU. Access to all HARTransit routes is available from the downtown Pulse Point. More info at HARTransit.com.

Rail:

Metro-North **Danbury Line** provides service to Danbury Railroad Station, with connections in South Norwalk and Stamford to **New Haven Line (Metro-North)** and **Amtrak** service. U-Pass is not valid on Amtrak (except Amtrak trains between New Haven and Springfield, excluding the Vermonter). Danbury Railroad Station is located .5 miles from WCSU. More info at MTA.info/mnr.

New York City: Trains available from South Norwalk or Stamford Station using **New Haven Line (Metro-North)** to Grand Central Terminal or **Amtrak** to Penn Station.

Carpool:

Use the **CTrides app** on iOS or Android to find other students, faculty, and staff looking to carpool to and from campus.

Airport Connection:

From Hartford Union Station, take CTtransit **30 – Kennedy Road (Bradley Flyer)** to Bradley International Airport 7 days/week. More info at CTtransit.com/services/bradley-flyer.

Use **New Haven Line (Metro-North)** or **Amtrak** service to get to New York City area airports.
