## Tuition and Fee Definitions

Full-Time	
<b>Tuition</b>	Tuition is the cost of the educational and instructional expenses associated with the full-time courses.
<b>University Fee</b>	The University Fee is used to support the costs associated with the maintaining and repairing of student facilities (buildings).
<b>University General Fee</b>	The University General Fee supports several operational costs, such as those associated with the student center, student ID processing, accident insurance coverage, intercollegiate athletics, and shuttle bus services.
<b>Student Activity Fee</b>	The Student Activity Fee is used to support university recognized clubs, student center programs, and student functions.
Part-Time	
<b>Tuition</b>	Tuition is the cost of the educational and instructional expenses associated with the part-time courses.
<b>University Fee</b>	The University Fee is used to support the costs associated with the maintaining and repairing of student facilities (buildings).
<b>University General Fee</b>	The University General Fee supports several operational costs, such as those associated with the student center, student ID processing, accident insurance coverage, intercollegiate athletics, and shuttle bus services.
<b>Student Activity Fee</b>	The Student Activity Fee is used to support university recognized clubs, student center programs, and student functions.
<b>Registration Fee</b>	The Registration Fee is charged each semester for part-time course registration.
Summer, Winter, & Spring Break Intersessions	
<b>Course Fee</b>	The Course Fee is assessed instead of semester based tuition and fees during intersessions (summer/winter/spring break). The fee is equivalent of part-time semester based tuition + university general fee.
<b>Registration Fee</b>	The Registration Fee is charged each semester for part-time course registration.
