TITLE 6 VI

OF THE
CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964

Prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, and national origin in programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance, like colleges and universities. Includes admissions, recruitment, financial aid, academic programs, student services, discipline, athletics, and housing.

TITLE 7 VII

OF THE
CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964

Prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, and gender identity, in employment, including at colleges and universities. Similar employment laws prohibit discrimination on the basis of age, disability, or genetic information.

TITLE 9 IX

OF THE EDUCATION
AMENDMENTS OF 1972

Prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex in programs and activities that receive federal financial assistance, like colleges and universities. Includes sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, stalking, and sexual exploitation.
