KATHWARI HONORS LAUNCHES NEW SPRING SEMINAR SERIES

The Kathwari Honors Program launched its Spring Seminars series with two thought-provoking events.

On February 8th, the Kathwari Spring Seminars series kicked off with a showing of "Do The Right Thing," including a panel discussion after the film hosted by Dr. Brian Clements. A panel including WestConn professors Qur-an Webb and Carina Bandhauer, administrator Joshua Sumrell, and student leader Gabriela Torres discussed the film and the social challenges people still face 35 years after the release of Spike Lee's classic.

On February 10, the Kathwari Spring Seminars hosted a discussion of Ruby Dee and Ossie Davis from "Do the Right Thing," as well as their legacies in American Black Theatre, American film, and civil rights. This discussion featured Dr. Khalid Long from Howard University, along with Dr. Donald Gagnon of the WCSU Department of Theatre Arts.

The series continues on February 24 at 3:30 PM, where Dr. Haneef Nelson of the WCSU Department of Music will discuss "Jazz, Hiphop, and Do the Right Thing" on Midtown Campus, Science Building, Room 125

On March 3 at 3:30 PM, four WCSU professors will discuss contemporary ethical quandaries from a variety of disciplinary perspectives in "What's Right Right Now?" with Dr. Anna Malavisi (History, Philosophy, and World Perspectives), Dr. Robert Whittemore (Social Sciences), Dr. Mitch Wagener (Biology), and Dr. Averell Manes (Emeritx, Social Sciences). The final seminar will take place on March 31 at 7:30 PM, where National Book Award-winning poet Martín Espada will give the debut reading from his new book of poems, Jailbreak of Sparrows. A book signing will follow. Westside Campus President's Reception Room
