Adjunct Teaching Positions**

Western Connecticut State University is pleased to announce applications are being accepted by the Department of Mathematics for part-time adjunct teaching positions for the upcoming semesters, including Fall 2020, Spring 2021, and future semesters.

The Department is in need of adjunct instructors to teach one to two upcoming daytime or evening classes in Developmental Mathematics, such as Elementary Algebra, Intermediate Mathematics, and Intermediate Algebra Plus, or in General Education Mathematics, such as Elementary Applied Mathematics (includes Linear Programming, Linear Algebra, and Theory of Interest topics), Elementary Statistics, and Intro to Biostatistics.

Adjunct instructors should be ready to teach either in the classroom, online, or in a hybrid fashion. Adjunct teaching is contingent upon enrollment, funding, and departmental need.

Since Adjunct instructor positions are ongoing pooled positions, your application material will remain on file and reviewed on an as needed basis for adjunct Instructor positions throughout the upcoming semesters.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Master's degree in a mathematical science. Previous teaching experience is preferred.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D. as well as previous university teaching experience.
