## **Eligibility:**

- Pursuing a research-focused Master's program in an NSF-supported field
- Have completed no more than twelve months of full-time graduate study or equivalent

- The program recognizes and supports outstanding graduate students in NSF-supported science and technology who are pursuing a research-based master's degree at accredited United States institutions.
- The GFRP's reputation follows recipients and often helps them become life-long leaders that contribute significantly to both scientific innovation and teaching.
