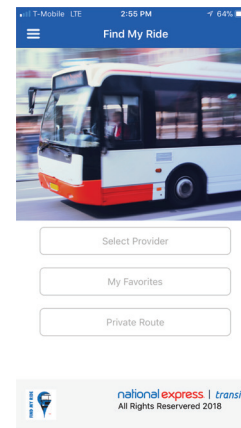
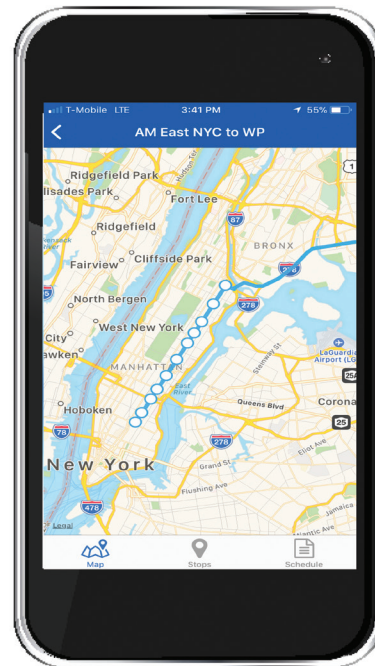

Find My Ride™ allows you to view your current bus' location and schedule. Get information about the route, in near real time, including the scheduled and estimated arrival times to your stop.



### Using the app:

1. Search and download "Find My Ride" from Google Play or the App Store.
2. Open the mobile app and click "Private Route".
3. Enter the Private Route code: WCSU then tap "Submit Code".
4. A list of available routes will display. Click the route name to display its detail. Click star to set route as a favorite.
5. Drag fingers on map to scroll or zoom.
6. Click 'Stop' icon to display street name and arrival/ departure time information.
7. Click the 'Stops' icon for list of stops on the route. Click the star to mark 'Stop' as favorite.
8. Click the 'Schedule' icon to display the routes schedule.
