While viviparity has evolved often, both within vertebrates as well as among invertebrates, mammalian [eutherian] pregnancy is unique in the degree of the integration between fetal and maternal individuals. In this talk, Wagner will summarize his recent work examining the cell biological mechanisms that had to evolve in order to make the uniquely mammalian fetal-maternal relationship possible.
