/20	Report: Best reports: are well-written (good grammar, clear construction), and explain everything the student did and why it is important and are in the student's own words (NOT PLAGIARIZED).	
/20	Illustrations or other visual products (website, etc): Best visual products: have a good design that is easy to read and understand.	
/20	Scope of project: Best scope: involves knowledge of science, takes place out in the community even beyond their home or school environments, may even involve recruiting other people, took at least several hours of the student's time over more than one day.	
/20	Execution of project: Best execution: Student enacted their vision and either completed or made significant progress on their projects.	
/20	Best science: Students demonstrate they learned something about environmental or other science beyond common knowledge such as littering or pollution in general being negative. Their presentation of science is accurate and not plagiarized.
