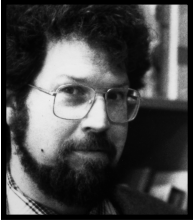

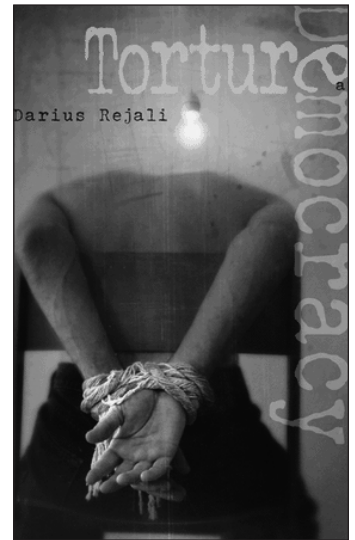

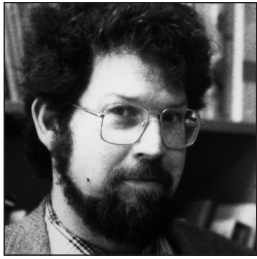

Steven Neuwirth was a longtime WestConn professor of English and specialist in Early American literature and history who died in February 2004. Neuwirth helped to establish the university's Honors Program and served as its first director; he contributed significantly to the organization of a multi-disciplinary American Studies curriculum at WestConn; and he served as a director of academic advisement services.
